3. Composition/information on ingredients

3.1 Mixtures

Composition: Styrene-acrylic dispersion, ground marble, titanium dioxide, processing additives, isothiazolinone-based biocide, water. Contains no organic solvents, non-toxic, non-flammable. VOC content (subcategory A/3): 75 g/l (from 2021), 40 g/l (from 2024). This product contains <40 g/l VOC.

4. First aid measures

General measures: In case of allergy symptoms, especially in the respiratory tract, seek medical attention immediately.

5. Firefighting measures

Extinguishing media: Not flammable under normal conditions. Adapt firefighting measures to the surrounding environment.

6. Accidental release measures

Avoid splashing and aerosol formation. Do not allow to enter drains. Contain spillage with a suitable absorbent and dispose of in accordance with waste legislation.

7. Handling and storage

Observe the usual precautions for handling chemicals. Store in the manufacturer's tightly closed original container, in a dry place, avoid cooling below +5°C and heating above +30°C. Storage class: 12 (non-flammable liquids).

Observe general hygiene measures when handling chemicals. Respiratory protection — not required; avoid inhaling vapours. Hand protection — protective gloves (nitrile) for prolonged contact.
